Application form guidelines:

1. Personal statement

You are requested to complete a 'Personal statement' which allows you to express your motivations and suitability for the programme you are applying to. There is a 1 000-word limit for the personal statement.

The personal statement should be written considering the following questions:

- Why do you want to undertake the programme or research?
- What are your academic interests?
- Why do you wish to study at UCL?
- What educational experience do you have?
- Do you have any relevant work experience?
- Have you completed any extracurricular and voluntary activities relevant to the programme?
- What are your career aspirations?

2. Details of two referees

At least one of your references must be academic and someone who has taught you at degree level. If you wish you may provide one professional reference in place of the second academic reference. Please ensure you have spoken to your chosen referees, so they are expecting an invitation to provide a reference for you, and are happy to do this. When providing the email address for your referee please use an academic or professional one rather than a personal one, e.g. john.smith@university.ac.uk rather than johnsmith@hotmail.com

3. The title of the UCL MSc course you wish to study
